All existing TVI products will continue to be compatible with both TVI and EdgeVis Servers.

What EdgeVis licences are available?

There are three licences and you must use the one suitable for your device.

- Feature capabilities depend on which level of EdgeVis Licence is purchased.
- Some require an individual licence per video source (e.g. attached camera) rather than a single licence per encoder. An encoder may require multiple licences if multiple cameras are to be attached.
- The server requires a new licence installed for each EdgeVis hardware purchase. This in turn means you must contact Digital Barriers for each EdgeVis hardware purchase and obtain a new licence. This licence, once installed on the server, adds the licences for the new encoders into their existing licensing pool.

Does EdgeVis use viewer licences?

Yes. Each EdgeVis encoder licence will be bundled with 10 viewer licences – which can be used on your EdgeVis Server to view any encoder.

What are main differences between EdgeVis Lite, Enhanced and Enterprise?

These licences have two main differences to the other licence types:

- An individual licence is required for each camera to be used with an encoder. Each encoder will be programmed in with a maximum number of cameras it supports.
- Each licence unlocks a certain level of functionality on an encoder.
- Each Encoder can only be assigned licences of the same type – it is not possible to mix and match licence types on a single encoder.

The following table outlines the capabilities of each licence – please be aware that the encoder must also be physically capable of supporting the feature (e.g. an IP100 cannot transmit 1080p, even if you load an EdgeVis Enhanced licence on to it).

IP Series devices must be purchased with an appropriate licence to unlock different levels of features.

- Each IP Series device requires one licence per attached camera
- All licences for an individual encoder must be of the same type

Q Series (MiniCam) products currently only support EdgeVis Enhanced licences.

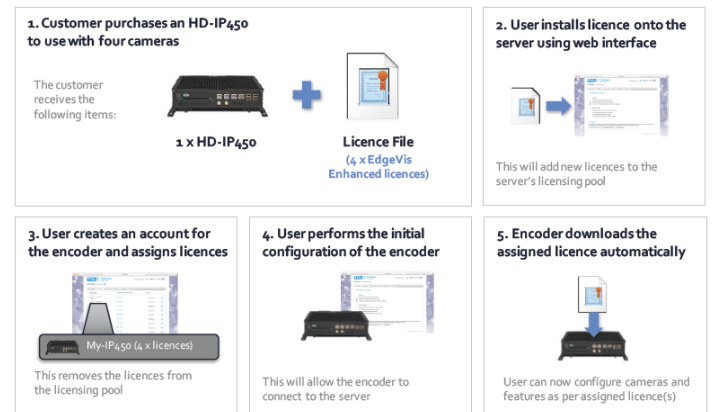

Do EdgeVis licences expire?

EdgeVis licences are perpetual and do not expire, unless they are specifically created as trial licences (e.g. for demonstrations).

The licence contains a maintenance expiry date which allows ongoing access to updates and fixes – this date is tied to your support contract date, after which point you will not be able to access or install new versions of the various EdgeVis software components. The maintenance period is tied to the expiry date of your support contract.

It will always be possible to install any software you have a licence for that was released during your maintenance period.



How does software maintenance work?

Each EdgeVis Server has a maintenance period, during which time EdgeVis Server updates can be installed. When that time has elapsed updates released after that date cannot be installed, but older versions released before that date can. It will always be possible to install any software you have a licence for that was released during your maintenance period.

The maintenance period is tied to the expiry date of your support contract.
